Bill has had the better part of 20 years developing restorative cultures in schools and training colleagues to do the same as a private consultant. Bill has written extensively on Restorative Practices and has authored / co authored five internationally published books on the topic. Bill is a Co-Director of Hansberry Educational Consulting and Co-Director of Fullarton House - Assessment, Therapy and Teaching.

While effective in addressing specific behavioural concerns, and in repairing the harm caused by wrongdoing and conflict, RP has evolved into a more comprehensive, relational, proactive approach to working with young people in schools.
